Regional education is learning or getting to know new places in the region where we live. During such classes, we learn about the history of our region, important dates that we should know and, above all, new people

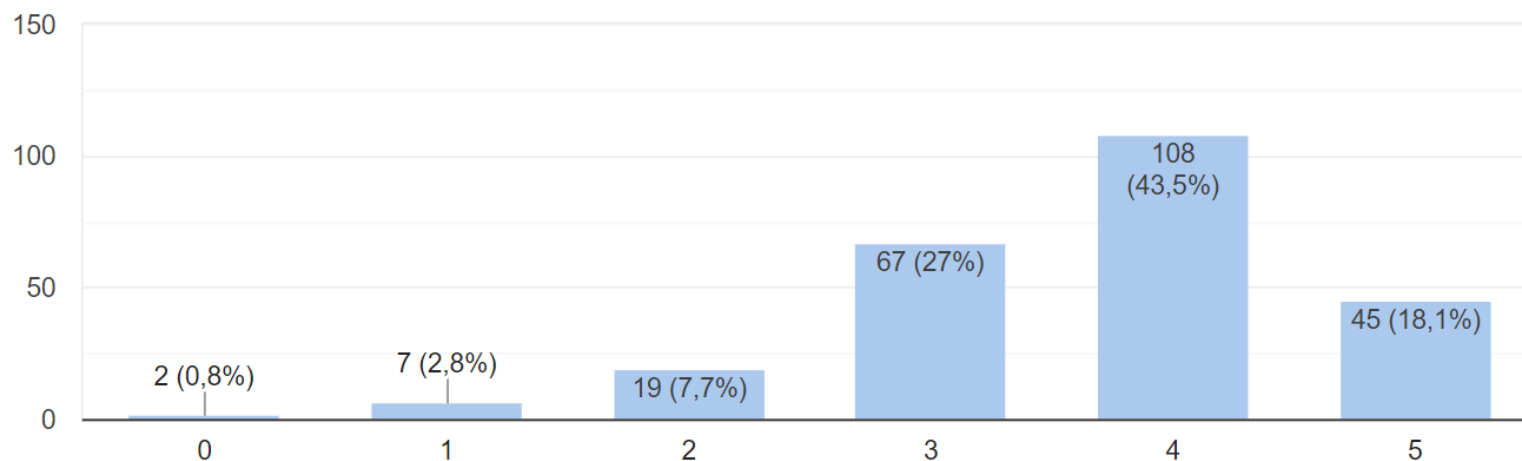
It is an opportunity to learn about the traditions, history and culture of our or a foreign city or region

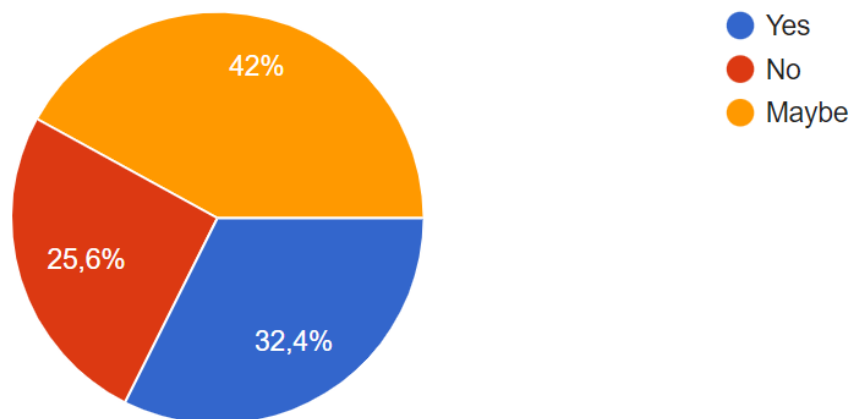

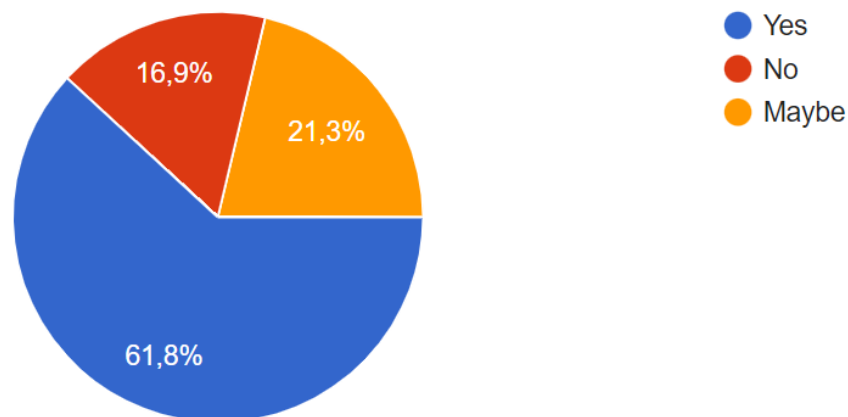

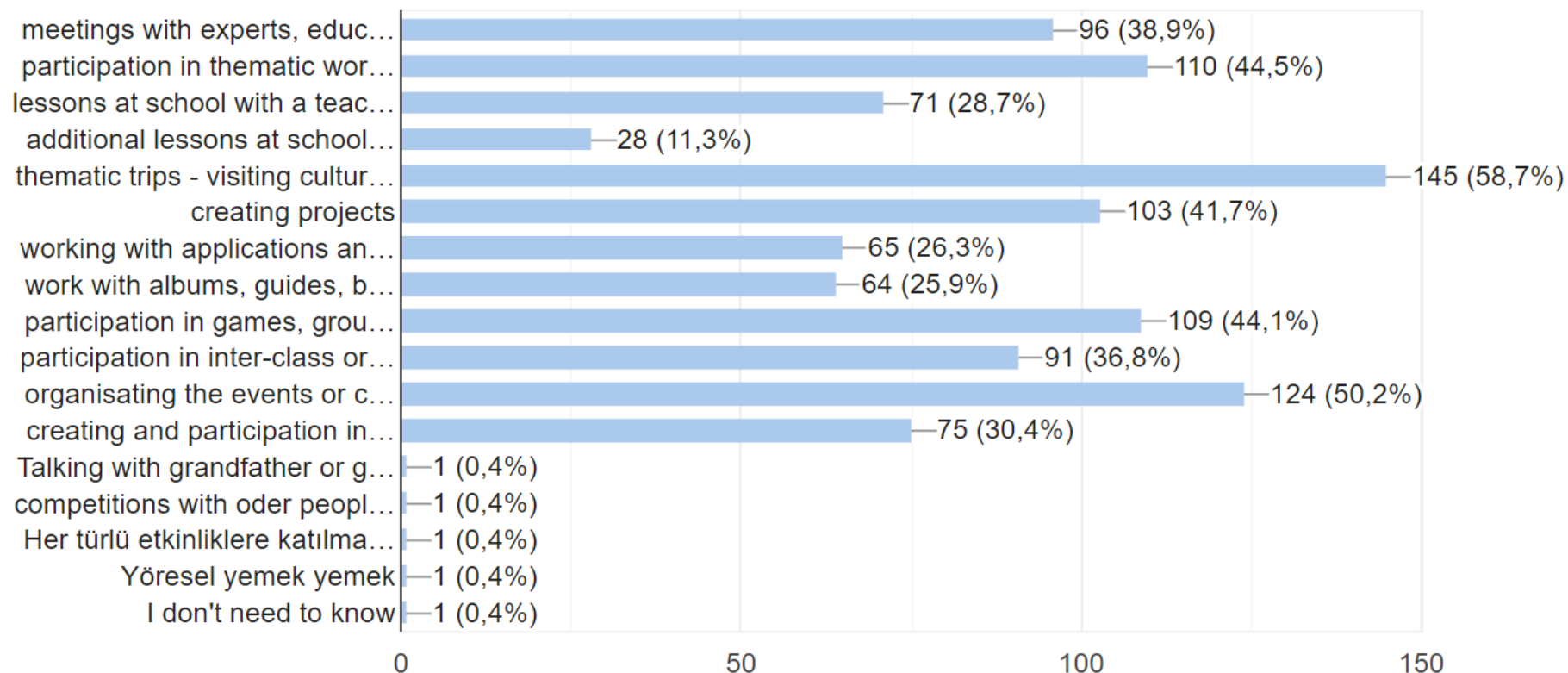

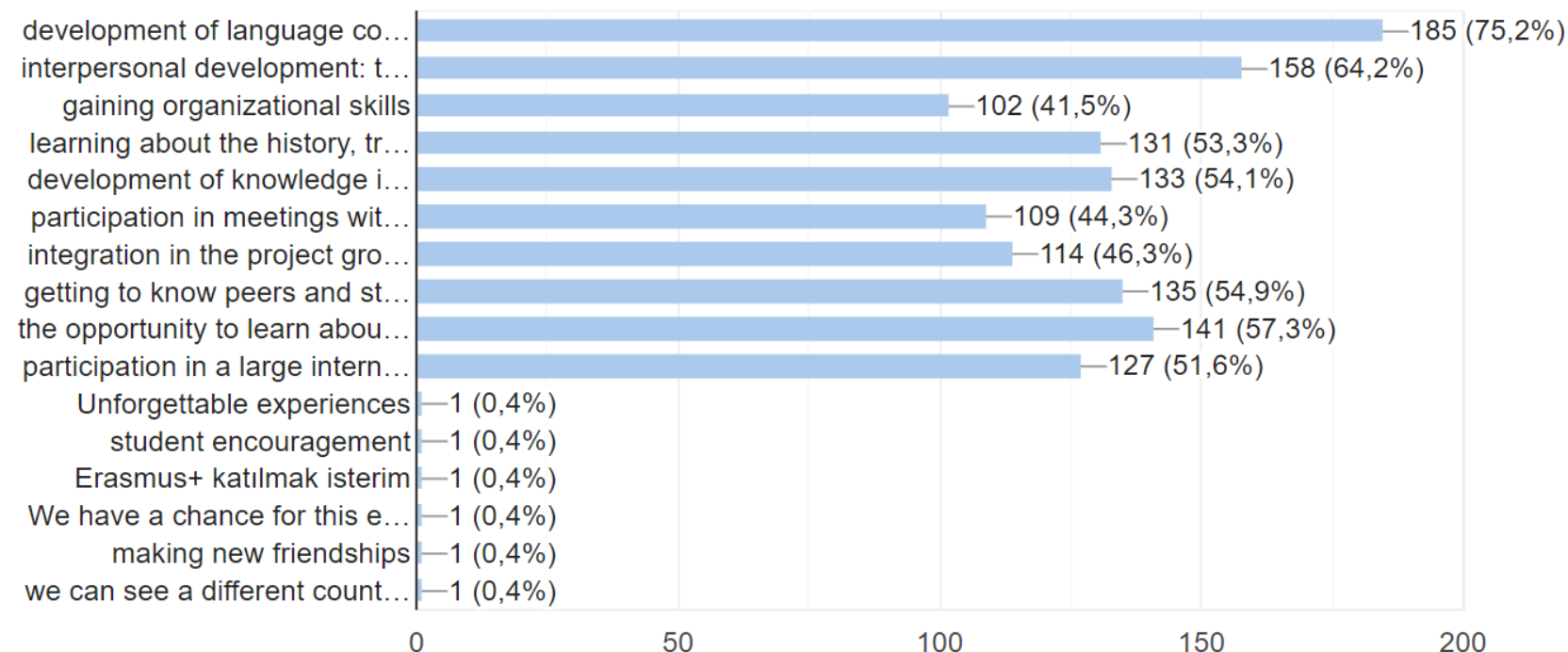
