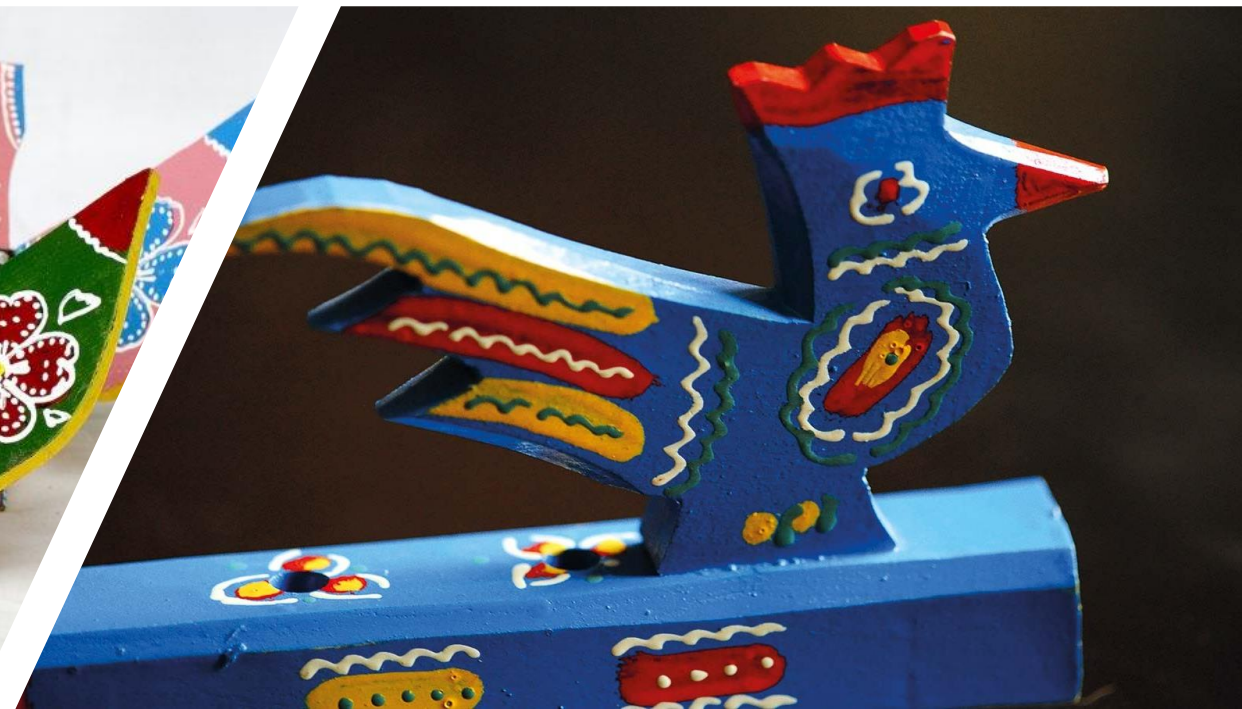


TRADITIONAL WOODEN TOYS



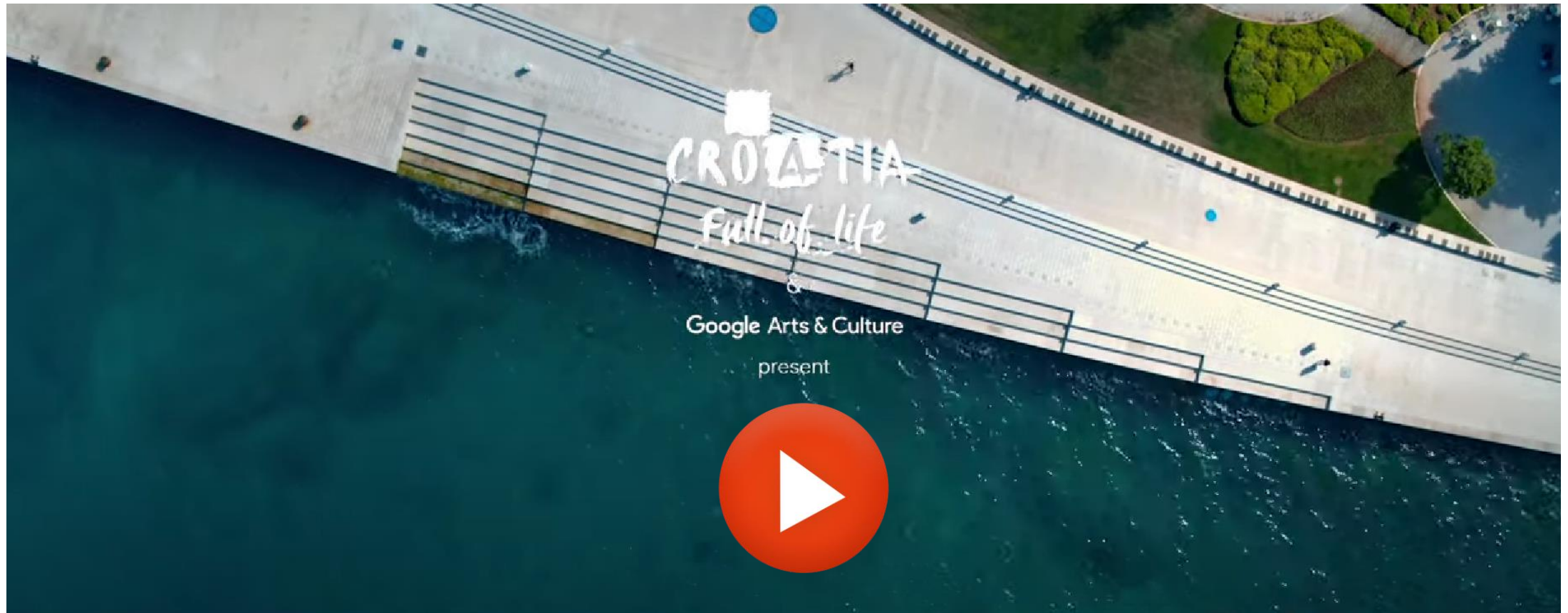
