TILE ART

Tiler art is a traditional turkish handicraft. It is formed by shaping the soil after cooking and producing goods. Tiler art consists of motifs, shapes and coloring. interior and exterior architecture is also used to color the works and to decorate them with motifs.

Ornamentation of items produced from baked earth is also a frequently used handicraft. The decorations made on items such as plates, porcelain, ceramics, titles are called "tile making".



TILE ART

“Tile making is quite laborious and difficult. Tile art is a handicraft that requires patience and effort. Tile is obtained as a result of many stages. The important thing in this branch of art is the dexterity, patience and skill of the person, because the works prepared did not reflect the person’s taste and imagination. Tile art is made by going through many stages. The works we see belong to one of the famous tile masters, Sıtkı Olçar, who has a UNESCO award.

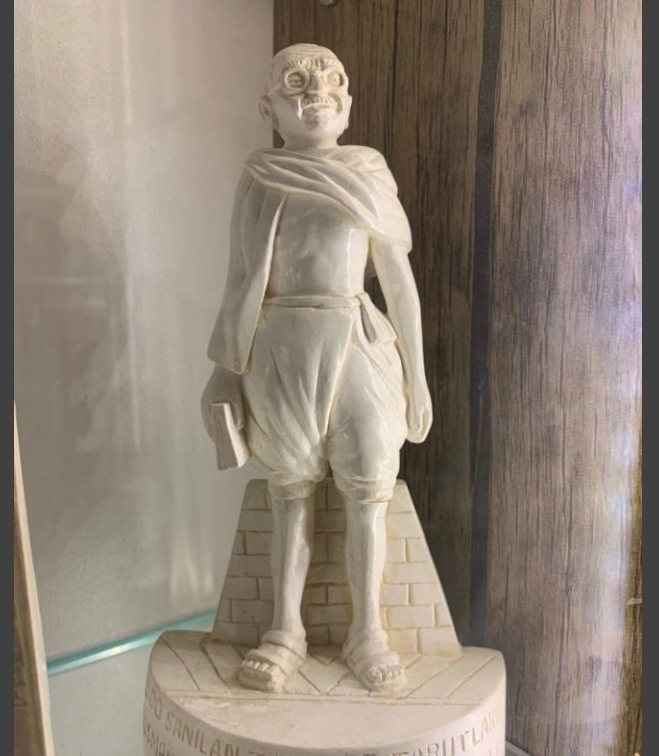
MEERSCHAUM ART

Meerschaum, also known as Eskişehir Stone in our country, is also called Meerschaum and Sepiolite in other languages.

MEERSCHAUM ART

Meerschaum is both an important business line and an art branch in Eskişehir. decoration, accessories are produced for the purpose of production. Embroidery workshops create different usage and preference areas by constantly developing new models. Meerschaum embroidery is a difficult and enjoyable handicraft that requires skill, experience and practice. Different parts of embroidery, different knives and tools specific to the job are used.





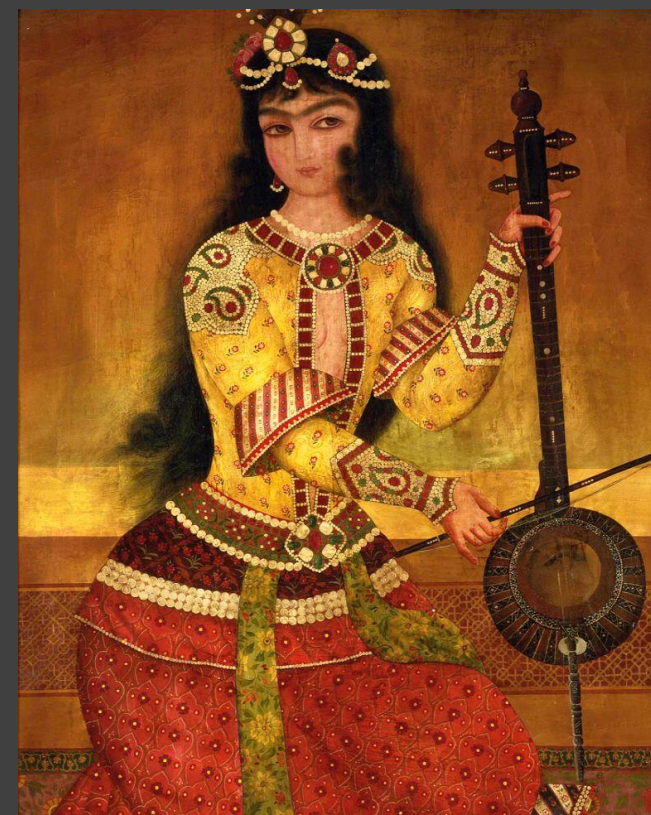

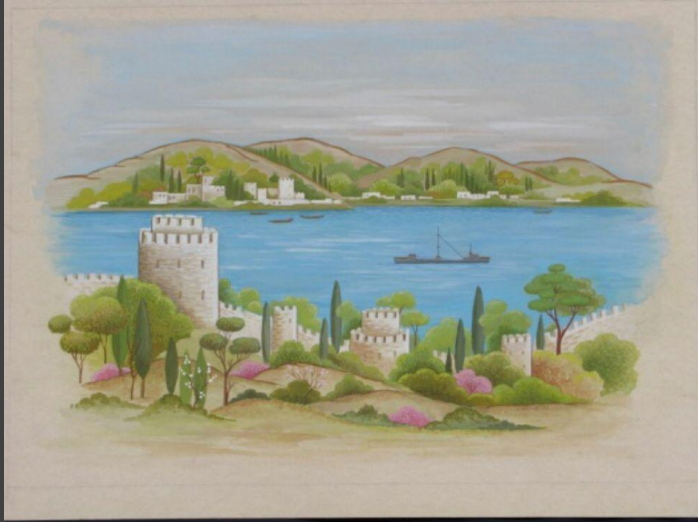


MINIATURE ART

Miniature is a traditional painting art with a very finely processed, small size, unique painting technique and expression language. It is applied to support the text in order to clarify the subject in manuscripts. The people who make this art are called Nakkaş.

STONEMASONRY ART

Stonemasonry is called the person who performs stone laying and repair works with his own unique techniques. It is one of the respected professions from the past to the present. The stonemason knows where and how to use the stones, what kind of work should be done to make them aesthetic and durable.

STONEMASONRY ART

It classifies natural stones and informs the customer about the selection of stones for the area to be work on it. Repairs distortions and fractures in previously applied stone works, protects and strengthens them. At the same time, by cleaning the stones, it ensures that it regains its first-day appearance. He also takes part in the restoration tasks in historical buildings.
