UMBRELLA MAKERS

- Cerovečki is the last traditional umbrella maker in Zagreb (open since 1912)

Cerovečki



ŠESTINE UMBRELLA

- mid-18th century
- a symbol of Zagreb
- has 8 wires
- red cotton canvas with multicolored stripes, a thick wooden stick and a naturally bent chestnut handle





TRADITIONAL POTTERS

- in Croatia – rich deposits of high-quality clay
- until mid-20th century
- objects for kitchens
- today – mainly decorative objects

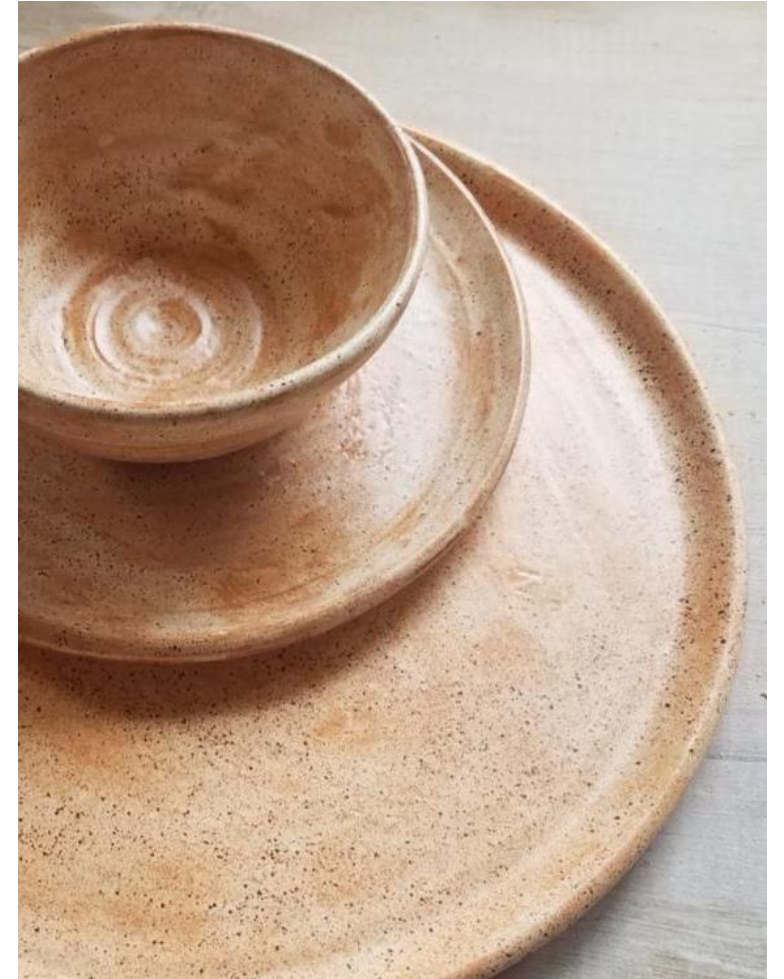
TRADITIONAL POTTERY



for storage

KLOBUČARI

- „klobuk” = „hat”
- people handmaking hats and caps
- more than 100 years old craft



NAŽIGAČ

- lights gas streetlights by hand
- since 1863
- now just on the Upper Town (246 lamps)
- tourist attraction
- only 2 in Zagreb





WEAVING

- textile formation on a loom
- a kneading technique
- a loom with horizontal base and two sheets





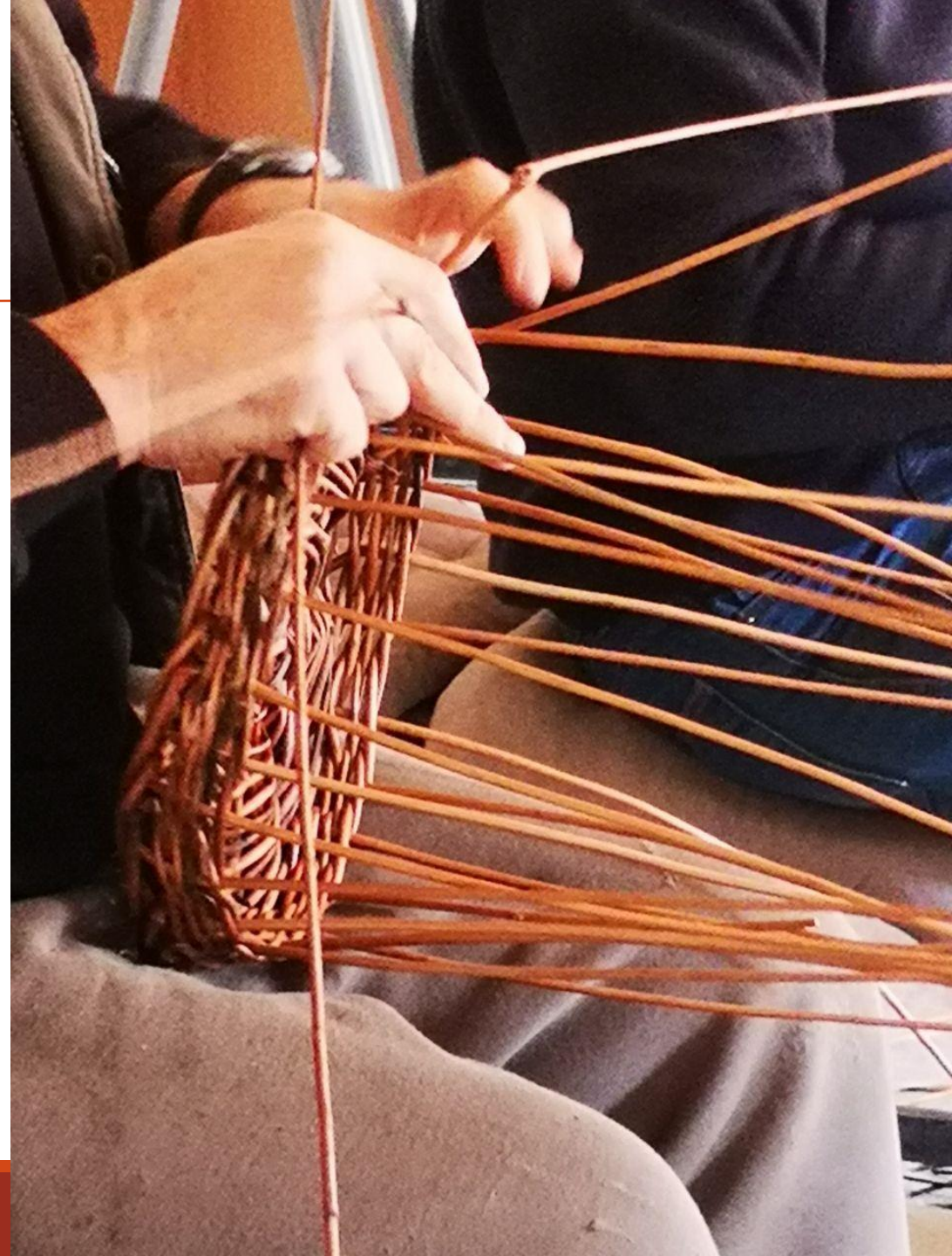
OPANČARI

- „opanak” – traditional shoe
- made of tanned leather
- since the 19th century



BASKET MAKERS

- „korpari”
- they knit baskets using willow tree branches





CLOCK MAKERS

- „urari”
- they repair old clocks and watches
- today – mostly replace bateries

BARREL MAKERS

- „bačvari”
- knowledge of wood
- today – mostly replaced by inox





TRADITIONAL ITEMS



SCHOOL CHALKBOARD

- before notebooks
- one side for writing text and the other for numbers
- special pen



RIFLJAČA (washboard)

- for washing clothes by hand
- a ridged tin surface as an aid and a base



SPINNING WHEEL

- old wooden spinning machine
- turned wool, linen, tow and cotton fibers into threads of yarn



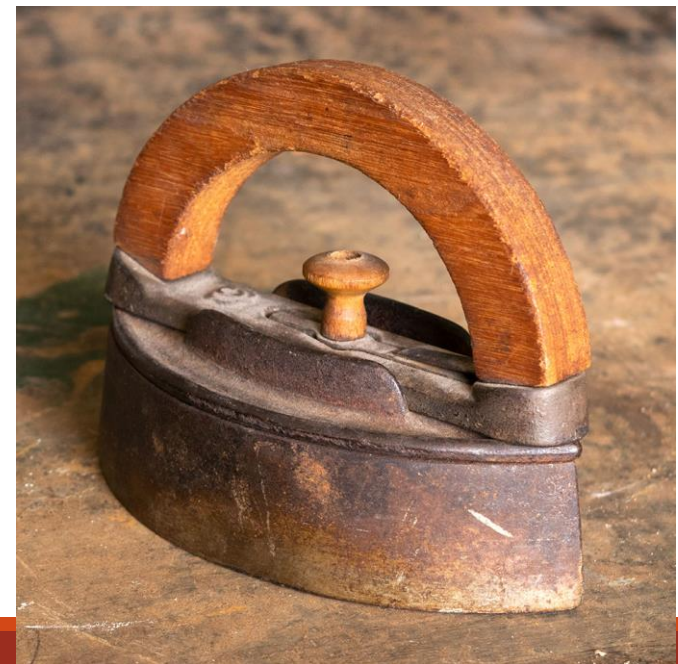
STAP

- wooden vessel for making butter
- sour milk is poured into it and beaten with a wooden handle



OLD IRONS

- heated by using coal or by fire on the stove





FOR COFFEE

- manual coffee grinders
- Turkish origins



FOR COFFEE

- manual coffee roaster
- roasting raw beans on a hot stove by rotating the handle
